

```
selector{  
  property1: value1;  
  property2: value2;  
}
```

This is the basic framework of a CSS selector block. Play close attention to the punctuation! One missing semicolon, and it won't work.

INTERNAL CSS*

```
<style type="text/css">  
div {  
  color: #90e0ef;  
}  
</style>
```

*You can also do external or inline CSS, but this is the way we're doing it in class.

TEXT PROPERTIES

```
p {  
  color: #d4a373;  
  font-family: Helvetica, sans-serif;  
  font-size: 14px;  
  text-align: left;  
  text-decoration: none;  
  line-height: normal;  
}
```

SPACING

```
div {  
  margin: 5px;  
  padding: 10px;  
  width: 500px;  
  border: 1px solid;  
}
```

Margin is space outside a box.
Padding is space inside a box.

REPEATING BACKGROUND IMAGE

```
body {  
  background-image: url("paper.gif");  
  background-color: #e9edc9;  
}
```

By default, background images will repeat vertically and horizontally unless you tell it not to do so.

FLOAT

```
img {  
  float: right;  
}
```

This will align all images on the right side and text will flow around the image.

STATIC BACKGROUND IMAGE

```
body {  
  background-image: url("sky.png");  
  background-repeat: no-repeat;  
  background-position-x: center;  
}
```

This will only display the background image once. It will be at the top and centered.
